- 2) Rain water is collected and stored in underground tanks. Back wash from the main pool is also channeled into this system. This water is used for irrigation on property which is done on a timer system.

- 1) In 2003 a new air cool scroll chiller central air-conditioning system was installed, which is more efficient than the window units and uses less harmful refrigeration gases.
- 2) Over 1000 compact fluorescent bulbs were installed in the gardens and guest rooms.

- 1) Guest rooms are being equipped with soap and shampoo dispensers to help reduce packing and therefore solid waste that goes to the landfill.

- 2) Office paper is printed on both sides or used as note paper; then shredded & distributed to chicken farms.
